Mathematics

During the Spring term, Reception will deepen their knowledge and understanding of number. This includes having a deep understanding of number to 10, including the composition of each number.

We will practise recalling number bonds to 5 and support the children to understanding addition facts.

For example

2+3=5

And 3+2=5 also

Personal, Social, and Emotional Development

We will be further developing our ability to moderate our feelings by identifying our feelings and sharing ways to deal with them appropriately. We will continue to have constructive and respectful relationships with our peers and discuss ways to be a good friend.

We will be learning to show resilience and perseverance in the face of a challenge by managing our emotions when a problem arises and needs solving.

Communication and Language

Children in Reception will be continuing to develop their ability to listen carefully to others speaking and stories and expanding our skills to ask questions to find out more as well as to check what has been said to them. They will be encouraged to learn and use new vocabulary throughout the day linking to our topics of 'The Natural World' and 'Our Community'. Further developing these skills, we will listen to non-fiction texts to extend our understanding of new knowledge and vocabulary.

Literacy

So far in Reception, we have been developing our phonics skills to recognise individual sounds and blend them to read. During the Spring term, we will be continuing with our learning and our next steps are to read simple sentences including green and red words.

We will be moving onto learning the sounds that some letter groups make e.g. sh, th, qu and using them in our reading and writing.

We will be developing our writing to begin writing simple sentences using finger spaces and full stops that are consistent with our phonics knowledge. We will be learning to read or writing back to check that it makes sense.

- Explore the natural world around you. Create observational drawings of plants and animals.
